STATE ENGAGEMENTS

- ▲ Odisha Farm Machinery Research & Development Centre (OFMRDC) in Odisha has initiated 1-month short-term training in the Combine Harvester Machine Operator job role at their campus. Under this Placement Linked Skill Development Training Programme, the candidates will be skilled in various aspects of operating, preparing & performing repair and maintenance of the combine harvester machine. The project is funded by OSDA.
- ▲ **HR Conclave in IIPM Bengaluru:** ASCI is invited to be on a Panel at the HR Conclave organized by the Indian Institute of Plantation Management (IIPM), Bengaluru on 25th November 2022. During the conclave, ASCI raised awareness among the stakeholders about the importance of skilling in the agriculture and allied sectors.









Promotion of Establishment of CoE in Horticulture, Bengaluru: ASCI held discussions with various stakeholders including the Indian Institute of Horticulture, Department of Horticulture, GKVK, UAS Bengaluru, Hithkari Nursery and Horticulture Foundation, Bengaluru during 1st & 2nd Dec 2022 to create awareness about the skilling in horticulture & importance of establishing Centre of Excellence in Horticulture. During the meeting, skill gaps in horticulture were also highlighted & proposed to align skilling programs in the upcoming Centre of Excellence planned to be established in Horticulture.

Upskilling of NDMC Employees

ASCI, in collaboration with New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) and NSDC conducted an Upskilling training programme at Skill India Center, Mandir Marg, New Delhi from 22nd Nov to 24th Nov 2022. The employees were imparted training on short modules like Propagation, preparation, establishing and maintenance of the Garden. Apart from this, the employees were also trained on the Designing, Setting and Maintenance of the Rooftop Garden with relevant safety and emergency procedures.

UPSDM – TRAINING & ASSESSMENT

During Oct-Dec 2022, 2,106 candidates trained across various job roles in various districts of UP. Out of that, 1,707 candidates got assessed and 1,510 candidates certified.

To support and facilitate the skill competencies in agriculture for the Maharashtra State, an MoU is signed between the Maharashtra State Skill Development Society (MSSDS) and Agriculture Skill Council of India on 01st October 2022.

This MoU aims at imparting skill-based training to around 6600 rural youth in agri-based vocational areas in agriculture & allied areas to promote employment in rural areas and create skilled manpower to perform farm and non-farm operations in Maharashtra.


UGC & SCHOOL PROGRAM

University Grants Commission

Under University Grants Commission, many colleges are running Agriculture & Allied courses. Out of which, ASCI assessed around 200 candidates of 5 UGC approved colleges. The courses covered are from various segments such as Beekeeping, Dairy Technology, Organic Farming, Green House Management, Tea Plantation, etc.

Samagra Shiksha

Under Samagra Shiksha, various states are running Agriculture courses from 9th to 12th class. Since Oct'2022, approx. 2,000 candidates have been assessed in State of Assam. The courses covered were Solanaceous Crop Cultivator, Animal Health Worker and Floriculturist-Open Cultivation.

WORLDSKILLS COMPETITION 2022

The WorldSkills Competition, a flagship event of the WorldSkills International, organised every two years, is the biggest vocational education and skills excellence event in the world that truly reflects global industry.

This WorldSkills Competition was 46th WorldSkills Competition. In view of the pandemic in China, WorldSkills Competition was conducted in a decentralized manner in 15 countries across Europe, Asia & the USA. Over 1,000 competitors from 58 countries in 62 skills, expected to participated in the WorldSkills competition 2022.

ROZGAR MELA

ASCI participated in Rozgar Mela organized at Kamakhya Nagar Stadium in Dhenkanal, Odisha on 6th November, 2022. The Rozgar Mela was a one-day event accompanied by other related activities including Career Counselling, Skill Exhibitions & Apprenticeship.

The event witnessed the participation from various PMKK, Apprenticeship undertaking organizations & several certified candidates under PMKVY and various skill development schemes.

Around 5 employers participated on behalf of the Agriculture SSC & around 30 candidates were placed in the job role of Packhouse Worker during the career fair at Dhenkanal, Odisha.

APPRENTICESHIPS & INTERNATIONAL PLACEMENTS

ASCI is continuously increasing its portfolio to appoint more apprentices under the NAPS and has done a substantial work in promoting apprenticeship and NAPS with various establishments. In the same endeavor, ASCI has appointed 250 apprentice under National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) during this quarter. The candidates have started "On the Job Training" with various agricultural establishments. The major job roles were from Agri Input sector like Agriculture Field officer and Agriculture Extension Service Provider.

It is also observed that establishments from Post-harvest sector are actively participating in apprenticeship program under the job role of Pack House Worker. This job role has recently picked up the numbers in appointing apprentices with various establishments.

ASCI has the objective of providing a skilled & certified workforce across the globe & has the vision to transform India into a preferred partner country to meet this objective. In the international placements, ASCI has placed 2 candidates in Germany as Meat Processing Associate & 6 candidates in Dubai i.e. 4 candidates as Gardener & 2 candidates as Landscape Technician.

CEDSI: NEXT DAIRY REVOLUTION

The Centre of Excellence for Dairy Skills in India (CEDSI) is an autonomous institution established under the aegis of the Agriculture Skill Council of India (ASCI) and the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) with the objective of overall Skill Development and Capacity Building in Dairy and Allied sector. CEDSI aims to ensure Sustainability and Profitability in the Dairy sector through Skilling and Capacity Building, Policy Advocacy & Knowledge Management and Research.

The promotion of sustainable FPO is a comprehensive process with legal formalities, developing a sound organizational structure and effective capacity building and governance systems etc., and above all a sound market linkage system for the end produce of FPOs. To achieve this, there is a need for a proper understanding of the basic concept of producer organizations. For this, CEDSI has prepared own training modules for FPO Training, covering each and every aspect for the FPO Members.

RECENT COLLABORATION WITH IGSSS FOR FPO CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM

A three-day Training cum Workshop Program has been organised for the Board of Directors and Members of the Farmers Producer Organisation (FPO) in Khalsa University, Punjab. The Training Program was conducted in collaboration with IGSSS (Indo-Global Social Service Society). The training was organized to orient farmers on key aspects of Dairy activities. Total of 15 Board Members of an FPO are trained. The program was organised in the 2nd week of October.
